## **Travel Directions to Luce Hall, 34 Hillhouse Avenue, New Haven, CT**

Metered parking is available on Hillhouse, Sachem & Trumbull Streets.

From Fairfield and West, and from New London and East, via I-95: Follow I-95 to New Haven, then I-91 north (toward Hartford). After one-quarter mile on I-91, take exit 3 (Trumbull Street). Go straight ahead off the ramp along Trumbull Street to the third traffic light, which is Hillhouse Avenue. Turn right and Luce Hall is at #34, on your left.

From Fairfield and West via Route 15: Follow Route 15 to exit 59 (Whalley Avenue). Go right at the foot of the off-ramp, then left at the light at Whalley. Follow Whalley south all the way to the center of town, where it becomes Elm Street and runs through Yale. Two blocks past York Street, at the northwest corner of the New Haven Green, turn left onto College Street. Turn right at your third light onto Trumbull Street. Turn left at first light onto Hillhouse Avenue. Luce Hall is #34 on your left.

From Hartford and North: Follow I-91 south to New Haven, where you take exit 3 (Trumbull Street). Go straight ahead off the ramp along Trumbull Street to the third traffic light, which is Hillhouse Avenue. Turn right and Luce Hall is at #34, on your left.

From Woodbridge, Bethany, and other western suburbs: Follow routes 63 or 69 into New Haven, where they become Whalley Avenue, and follow Whalley all the way to the center of town, where it becomes Elm Street and runs through Yale. Two blocks past York Street, at the northwest corner of the New Haven Green, turn left onto College Street. Turn right at your third light onto Trumbull Street. Take 1st left onto Hillhouse Avenue. Luce Hall is #34 on your left. Turn left at first light onto Hillhouse Avenue. Luce Hall is #34 on your left.
