

February 16, 2018 – The Battle to Ratify the Equal Rights Amendment is Still in Play

Nevada ratified the Equal Rights Amendment on 3/22/2018 which leaves 14 unratified States. (AZ, AL, AR, FL, GA, IL, LA, MS, MO, NC, OK, SC, UT and VA)

"Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex"

We need 2 more States to ratify and the House and Senate to hold hearings on HJRes53 & SJRes 5 to drop the arbitrary 1982 ERA Deadline.

Last Friday while activists sang "We Shall Overcome," 8 men in Virginia voted not to allow the ERA out of Committee into hearings. Arizona is in play but it looks like we will face a similar blockage.

Today out of the blue Missouri announced that it is going to hold hearings on Tuesday morning 2/20 at 9AM, in the Missouri State Senate, 201 W Capital Avenue Jefferson City MO 65101 Room Senate Lounge on whether the State should ratify the ERA.

We need people to show up to support ratification. We need people to testify at the hearing. If you know women in Missouri, ask them to contact their legislators and ask them to vote to ratify the ERA.
